It aims to ensure all people have access to a dignified life: income, housing, education, healthcare, and opportunities.



WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?



- Over 700 million people live in extreme poverty.
- Poverty limits access to education, healthcare, clean water, and decent jobs.
- It affects women, children, and rural communities the most.



MAIN TARGETS OF SDG 1

- ✓ End extreme poverty
- ✓ Reduce by at least half the proportion of people living in poverty.
- ✓ Implement social protection systems (subsidies, pensions, financial aid).
- ✓ Ensure equal access to basic services: education, water, housing, healthcare
- ✓ Boost resilience of vulnerable communities to disasters and crises.
