Help more countries achieve more sustainable consumption by 2030 to halve waste, which would help us achieve food security.

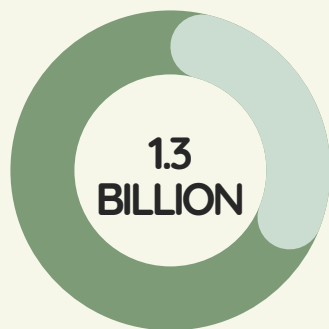


## RESPONSIBLE OBJECTIVES

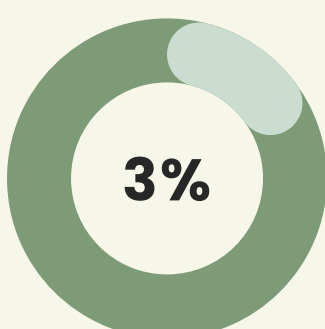
- With the participation of all countries, have sustainable consumption and production programs.

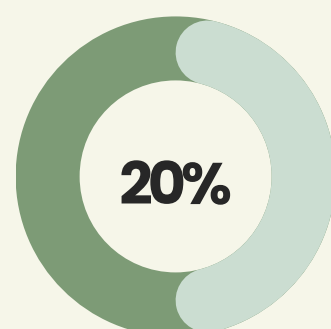
## SOME INTERESTING FACTS
